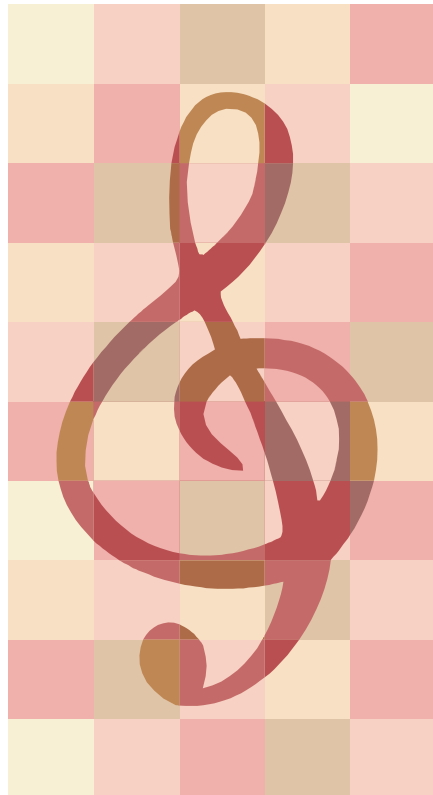
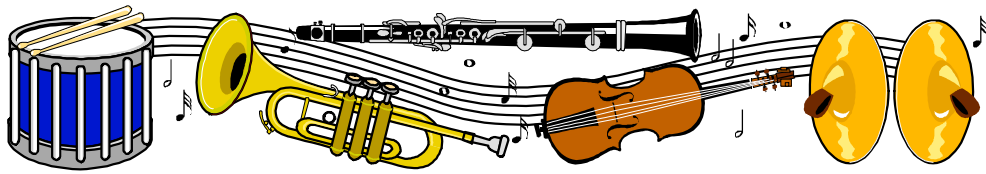

GUIDELINES FOR MUSIC PROJECTS

1. CATEGORIES

- Song Writing
- Vocal
- Instrumental
- Dance
- Combination (Any combination of categories listed above.)

A. Coal must be the topic

B. Entry may be from a familiar or popular song or can be an original of your own.

C. Entry must be performed on video or audio cassette, CD, DVD, or flash drive (memory stick).

2. MUSIC TYPE

- Country
- Rap
- Pop/Rock
- Bluegrass
- Ballad
- Classical
- Gospel

3. LENGTH OF ENTRY

Minimum: 1.5 minutes

Maximum: 5 minutes

4. ORIGINAL WORK

A. Extra points will be given for any part of an entry that is an original work.

B. A description of any original work should be stated on your video/audio tape, CD, DVD, or flash drive prior to the beginning of your performance in order to ensure extra points are given.

C. For the judges' convenience, a copy of the lyrics should be enclosed in a clear-front presentation folder even if a freestanding, three-sided display board is used.

NOTE: Judges will be looking for knowledge of the subject (coal), length of project, originality of lyrics, creativity, ability to perform, the quality of the performance, and voice quality.

CEDAR will provide TV/VCR or DVD players, computers, and CD/audio cassette players for entries in the Music category.

No live performances will be permitted; however, students will be allowed to meet with the judges to explain/discuss their entry.

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**Projects that do not meet all guideline limitations will not be considered for the awards program.
(Guideline limitations are shown in bold print.)**
